

On October 20, we observe World Mission Sunday and stand in solidarity with the Missions of the Church, to proclaim the salvation of Christ to all nations. Pope Francis reflected on this year's theme: "Go and Invite Everyone to the Banquet" Matthew 22:9. Participating in this is a tangible way for Catholics to live out the Great Commission, bringing the message of Christ to every corner of the earth. Founded by French laywoman Blessed Pauline Jaricot in 1822, the Society for the Propagation of the Faith is an essential source of aid for the Church's missionary work.
