Divine Mercy Chaplet



Available to you today is a Divine Mercy Chaplet/Novena pamphlet. Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet daily is a very strong petition to God to save America from total destruction/war/chastisements. Praying the Divine Mercy Novena from Good Friday (3/29) to Divine Mercy Sunday (4/7) and going to Confession and Communion will gain you a Plenary Indulgence. If you are not in need of a plenary indulgence, you can transfer it to a deceased person in Purgatory. A full Plenary Indulgence removes all temporal punishment due to one's sins if all the requirements are met. In other words, when you go to Confession, your sins are forgiven after you do your penance. But... you still have to do the "time for the crime" (aka temporal punishment) in Purgatory. However, on Divine Mercy Sunday, after completing the Novena, going to Confession and Communion, you may petition God for a Plenary Indulgence to erase the time you would have spent in Purgatory. God is urging you to please take advantage of the opportunity He is offering through the Divine Mercy Novena.
