





The Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary is celebrated on the Saturday after the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). In 2025, this date will be June 28. This feast honors Mary's interior life, purity, love for God, and her role as a mother.

The Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary is a devotional title that refers to Mary's spiritual heart, her joys and sorrows, virtues, and her love for God the Father, Jesus, and all people. It emphasizes her pure love for God and humanity, her maternal compassion, and her sorrows and joys as the mother of Jesus.
