

WHAT IS OCIA?

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. The OCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. It was the early Church's way of Christianizing the pagan Roman Empire. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church. Classes begin: September 3, 2025. Welcome Father Mwesiga

I am Fr Derick Mwesiga.I was born and raised in Bukoba Tanzania and was ordained a Priest on July 7th 2018 in the Catholic Diocese of Bukoba in Tanzania. I am a Diocesan Priest incardinated to the Diocese of Bukoba but currently I am serving as a missionary in the Catholic Diocese of Peoria, Illinois as Parochial Vicar at Most Holy Eucharist Parish and Chaplain at Central Catholic High School in Bloomington Illinois.

Bukoba Catholic Diocese is one the 34 Diocese found in Tanzania, East Africa. It is located in the northwestern part of the country on the shores of Lake Victoria. The Diocese is made of 48 parishes and more than 300 outstations most of which are in underdeveloped areas with people relying on subsistence small scale farming activities.

Meeting the expenses of running the Diocese with its institutions is a big challenge to the Diocesan authorities. Because of this the Diocesan Bishop of Bukoba requested to participate in the 2025 Missionary Appeal plan in the Diocese of Springfield. The purpose of this mission appeal is supporting the education of the seminarians. The Diocese is blessed with vocations to priesthood but it is struggling in educating the future priests and so asks for your generous support. The full formation of a seminarian to priesthood takes eight years in which he studies philosophy and theology. The annual cost for the education of one seminarian in Tanzania is USD 2500.00. Considering the poor state of the families, the diocese has to take care of over 60 seminarians through all this formation and education which is a challenge.

Please kindly consider supporting the diocese of Bukoba in the struggle to get workers for the Lord's vineyard and shepherds of the Lord's flock.
