Save the date! Saturday, **12/13/25** is breakfast with Santa in the school gym. More info coming soon!

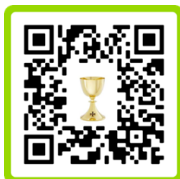


Attention all parishioners!
