DROP OFF/PICK UP PROCEDURE

Staff will be at the Preschool door, the door in the primary wing, and at the Enrichment Center/gym entrance to let students in each morning. Pull into the parking lot off of Butcher Street and then proceed to either the primary wing door or Enrichment Center/gym door. If you need to get out of the car, please park away from the doors so we can keep traffic moving. If you have a child in preschool and an older sibling, they may all enter through the preschool door.

LUNCH 8/17 & 8/18

Tomorrow we have a noon dismissal for the first day of school. If your child is going to aftercare tomorrow, Thursday, 8/17 they will need to bring a packed lunch to school. Lunch for Friday, 8/19 will also need to be brought for everyone. Monday, 8/21 is the first day space camp lunch will be available.

SPIRIT DAYS

Thursdays will once again be Spirit Days. Students may wear their Spirit T-Shirts on Thursdays with their uniform jumpers/skirts/shorts. Becky DiPaolo is still taking orders if you would like to order a

EXTRA CURRICULAR SIGN UPS

HOT LUNCH

Hot lunch will start to be served on Tuesday, 9/5. Lunch is provided to our students from Bethalto School District. The cost this year is \$3.25 per lunch. Lunch orders for the week of 9/5 are due no later than Thursday 8/31. Send a note with the days your child wants to order and the money with your child in an envelope marked "Hot Lunch". Once the order is received your child will receive a lunch order receipt to bring home within a couple of days.

STATE RECORDS

The State of IL requires us to gather the following forms from students entering certain grades.

<u>PreK</u>- We need a copy of your child's certified Birth Certificate before the 1st day of school. We also need a school physical on file.

<u>Kindergarten-</u> If you have not attended OLQP for PreK, we need a copy of your child's certified Birth Certificate before the 1st day of school, State of IL Dental Exam Form, State of IL Eye Exam Form, and a School Physical completed within the last 12 months with up to date vaccinations on it.

<u>2nd-</u> We need a State of IL Dental Exam Form turned in for 2nd grade.

<u>6th-</u> We need a State of IL Dental Exam Form for 6th grade turned in and also a school physical completed with up to date vaccinations for 6th grade.

CMG CONNECT

The **CMGConnect** online training replaces the former Safe Environment Program (VIRTUS "Protecting God's Children") that was previously offered through our Archdiocese. Individuals are now required to complete all Safe Environment Training online.

CMG connect is a new web-based platform that will assist the Diocese to ensure that all employees and volunteers who are in a position of trust with children and vulnerable adults within our schools and parishes are trained to recognize behavior patterns of potential abusers and provide proactive measures for preventing abuse in any context. This class needs to be completed before volunteering at the school and to complete most service hour opportunities. SCHOOL PICTURES

School picture order forms were sent home on Sunday, 8/13. School pictures are scheduled for Monday, 8/28. Free dress is allowed for picture day. FACULTY/STAFF TRAINING DAYS

The faculty and staff have been busy preparing for the return of our students by attending training days aimed at keeping them safe. Officer Shank from the Bethalto Police Department came in and did another intruder training. He provided valuable information and suggestions that we will use to continue to make sure our school is as safe as possible.

We also attended a CPR certification class in order to make sure we are as prepared as we can be in the case of a medical emergency.

DOOR/SECURITY CHANGES

Recently, we had locksmiths come and work on our doors to add extra security features. They made it to where when someone unlocks the door to enter the building, it is impossible to leave it unlocked. The key cannot be removed from the door until it is in the locked position.

BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

We welcome Beth Kearns as our director of Caring Hands- our before and after school program. She will be checking id's when students are being picked up until she is familiar with everyone. Thank you for helping her keep our kids safe.

DRESS CODE
