Cookbooks will be shipped within 4-6 weeks after recipes are submitted.

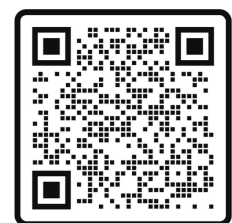

- Click 'Add Recipes' to begin adding your recipes.

Recipe Writing Tips:



SCAN ME

- When adding recipes, review the “Tips” and use standard abbreviations.
- Only enter 1 ingredient per ingredient line.
- List ingredients in order of use in the ingredients list and directions.
- Include container sizes, e.g., (16-oz.) pkg., (24-oz.) can.
- Write directions in paragraph form, not in steps.
- Use names of ingredients in the directions, e.g., “Combine flour and sugar.” DO NOT use statements like, “Combine first three ingredients.”
- Include temperatures and cooking, chilling, baking, and/or freezing times.
- Additional comments about the recipe (history, nutritional data, suggested uses, etc.) are not allowed unless a “Recipe Note” field is visible. Enter extra recipe content in that field.

CMG CONNECT

The **CMGConnect** online training replaces the former Safe Environment Program (VIRTUS “Protecting God’s Children”) that was previously offered through our Archdiocese. Individuals are now required to complete all Safe Environment Training online.

CMG connect is a new web-based platform that will assist the Diocese to ensure that all employees and volunteers who are in a position of trust with children and vulnerable adults within our schools and parishes are trained to recognize behavior patterns of potential abusers and provide proactive measures for preventing abuse in any context. **This class needs to be completed before volunteering at the school and to complete service hour opportunities.** Attached below is info about how to complete the class and the website to do it at.

HOT LUNCH

We will begin serving hot lunch from the public school beginning on Tuesday, September 2nd. Public school hot lunch this year will be \$3.00/meal and include milk. Ordering can be done by sending in the dates your child wants to order and the payment in a marked envelope labeled "Lunch Order" with your child to school. Orders can be done for an entire month at a time or every week. September's monthly order will be due by **Thursday, 8/28 at 9am** and weekly orders will be due the Thursday before the week you are wanting to be served lunch. Example: The order for the week of 9/1-9/5 will be due on Thursday, 8/28 by 9am.

DRAMA CLUB

We are in the planning stages of bringing back our drama club for grades 4-7. We are wanting to do a spring musical. In the extra curricular survey that was completed last spring, we had about 10 students interested. **If your child said they were interested in Drama last spring on the extra curricular sign up form, please confirm** with Mrs. Knight that they would still like to participate so we can get an accurate count.
