SICKNESS

We have already had some sicknesses going through the building. If we send your child home with a fever, they cannot return to school the next day. Please do not send your student back to school until they are fever free for 24 hours, have been on antibiotics for 24 hours (if applicable), or a doctor's note states that your child can return the next day.

Covid protocol- We are following the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois State Board of Education's guidelines when it comes to covid. If your child tests positive:

- They cannot return to school for 5 days.
- They can return to school on day 6 if they have been fever free for 24 hours and symptoms have improved, but need to be masked through day 10.
- If you have multiple children, your other children may come to school as long as they are symptom free. On day 5, those children should also be tested.

FACTS GRADEBOOK

Parents are able to login to their school FACTS Family Portal account to check their child's grades. This is the same account you use for your enrollment packet yearly. Click "student on the left hand side menu . Next, click on "grades". You can then change between classes to view current grades for each subject listed.

PSA

All parents are automatically members of the PSA. Decisions are made at these meetings that impact all of our students. The first meeting of the school year will be held on Tuesday, 9/5.
