

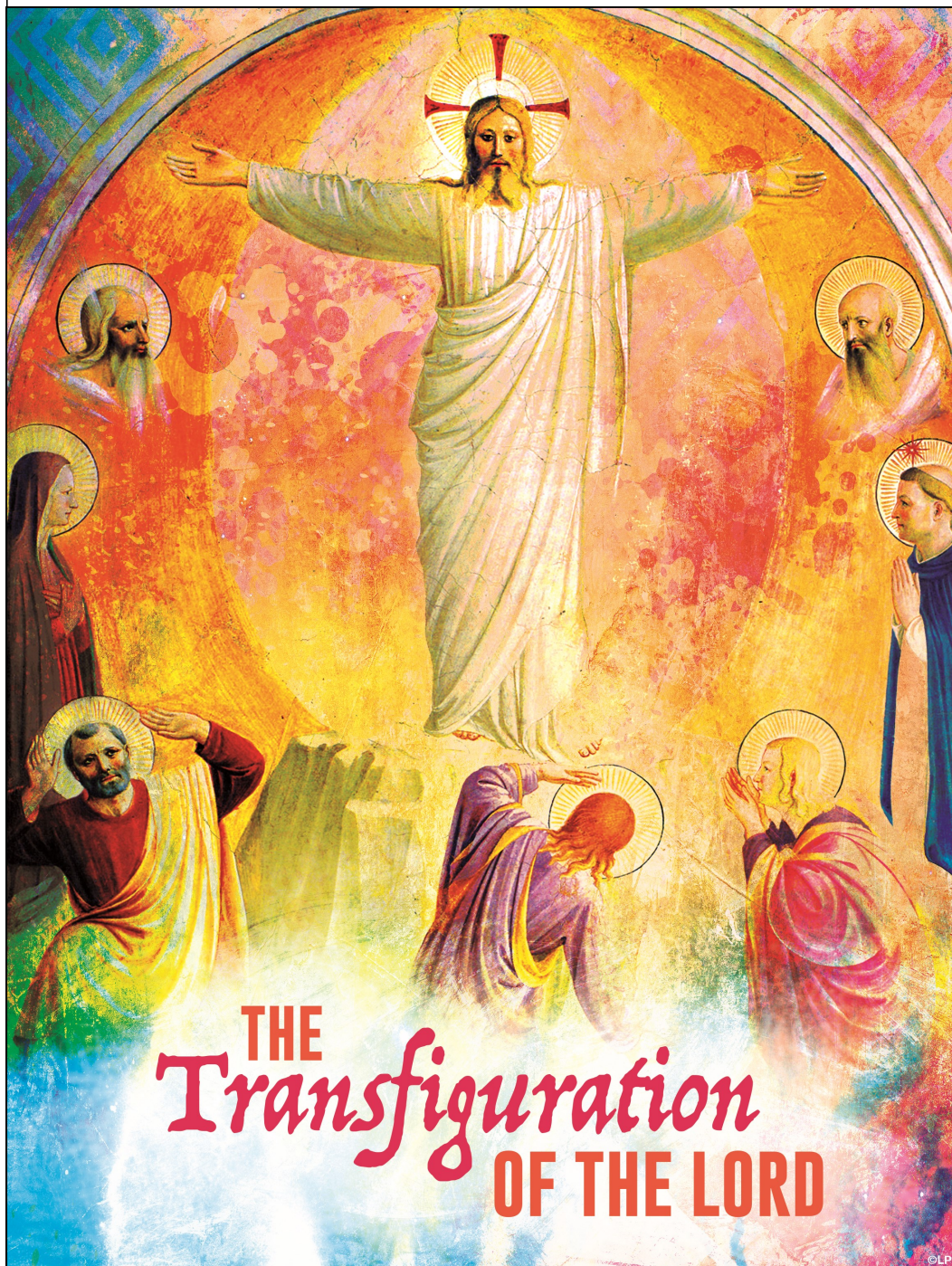

RCIA



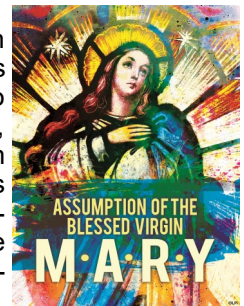
