### **CMG CONNECT**

The **CMGConnect** online training replaces the former Safe Environment Program (VIRTUS "Protecting God's Children") that was previously offered through our Archdiocese. Individuals are now required to complete all Safe Environment Training online.

**CMG connect** is a new web-based platform that will assist the Diocese to ensure that all employees and volunteers who are in a position of trust with children and vulnerable adults within our schools and parishes are trained to recognize behavior patterns of potential abusers and provide proactive measures for preventing abuse in any context. This class needs to be completed before volunteering at the school and to complete service hour opportunities. Attached below is info about how to complete the class and the website to do it at.

# **HOT LUNCH/SPACE CAMP LUNCHES**

We will begin serving hot lunch from the public school beginning on Wednesday, September 4th. Look for more information regarding public school hot lunch and Space Camp sponsored lunch in the welcome packet on your child's desk at the Open House this Sunday. Public school hot lunch this year will be \$3.50/meal and include milk. Ordering can be done by sending in the dates your child wants to order and the payment in a marked envelope labeled "Lunch Order" with your child to school. Orders can be done for an entire month at a time or every week. September's monthly order will be due by Thursday, 8/29 at 9am and weekly orders will be due the Thursday before the week you are wanting to be served lunch. Example: The order for the week of 9/2-9/6 will be due on Thursday, 8/29 by 9am.

In order to raise money to send the 7th and 8th graders to Space Camp in Huntsville, Alabama, (and so you don't have to pack lunches the first two weeks of school) students sponsor lunches during the weeks of August 19th and August 26th.
