Important Update!!! Bethalto wants us to turn our lunch orders in on Wednesday now. **Lunch orders will have to be due on Wednesday at 9AM from now on.** Hot Lunch this year will be \$3.00/meal and include milk. Ordering can be done by sending in the dates your child wants to order and the payment in a marked envelope labeled "Lunch Order" with your child to school. Orders can be done for an entire month at a time or every week. Example: The order for the week of 12/15--12/19 will **be due on Wednesday, 12/10.** The January menu went home this week. Due to the break coming up and it being a new menu that is being offered... January monthly orders are due next Wednesday, 12/10 by 9AM. SCRIP FOR CHRISTMAS

It's not too early to begin thinking about your SCRIP order for Christmas!!! They order weekly, and should have no problems in getting your orders in before Christmas is upon us. Just visit the above website to see all of the retailers who participate. If you set up an account, you can also place an order directly on the website. To do this, you will need this enrollment code: FF1ECBD61859 Questions, just give the parish office a call, 618-377-6519. The church keeps 20% of the rebate back and gives 80% of the money back to school families. This amount can be used to pay off tuition, pay your caring hands bill, or to order more SCRIP.
