Closing for Weather

We will NOT cancel school if they close due to cold weather. If school is canceled, you will receive a text message and email through the FACTS system and it will also be posted on social media as well as Fox 2 News.

Note: When school is canceled due to weather conditions, all evening events at our school are also canceled. This is for insurance/liability reasons. This includes practices, games, meetings, or anything else that is scheduled for the evening on those days.
