GOING DEEPER THIS LENT...

Lent isn't simply about "giving up" something. The real grace is when we recognize that Lent is a season in which God wants to give us something. God wants to help us transform our lives and make us more free as people—not just freer with God, but in the way we live our lives and love our families.

What is God inviting me to change this Lent? How do I know what God may be stirring in me? I begin by listening to the movements in my heart. When am I feeling uncomfortable with the choices I am making? With the things I have done? With the habitual ways I respond? The Lord will be speaking to me in those small nagging moments of discomfort in my heart. What do I need more of in my life? Patience? Unselfishness? More loving behavior toward my spouse or children?

Where do I need a breakthrough? What is the barrier that keeps us from asking for healing? In own lives, we need to break through our denials, defensiveness and our unwillingness to look at ourselves. Discovering that the barrier in my life is critical. If we don't know what it is, these weeks of Lent are a great time to reflect upon it. When we identify the barrier, we have made a breakthrough. That's when Jesus can heal us of it.
