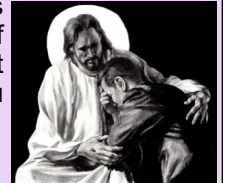

Sacrament of Confession

Schedule for upcoming Confession times can be found inside this bulletin. If you've been away from the Sacrament for a while, below is a guide to assist you in preparing:

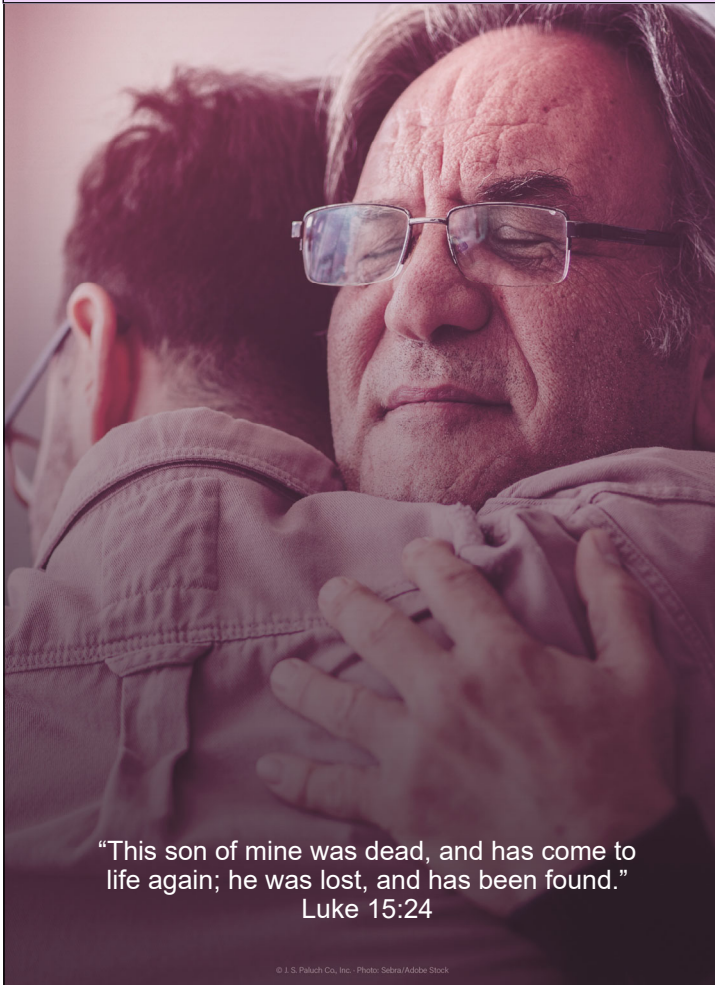


Guidelines for Confession

- 1) Pray and examine your conscience. If you need help, go to: <http://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/sacraments-and-sacramentals/penance/examinations-of-conscience.cfm>
- 2) Once with the priest in Confession, make the sign of the cross and say, "**Bless me, Father, for I have sinned.**" Then tell him how long it's been since you've been to Confession.
- 3) **Confess your sins** to the priest.
- 4) When finished, say "**I am sorry for these and all of my sins**". Don't worry if you forgot something. This closing statement covers everything that didn't come to mind in the moment.
- 5) The priest will assign you a penance.
- 6) Express sorrow for your sins by saying an Act of Contrition.

"Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended thee and I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments, but most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen."

- 7) The priest, acting again in the person of Christ, will absolve you ending with, "I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, Son and of the Holy Spirit." You make the sign of the cross and say, "**Amen.**"
