

### What is the RCIA Rite of Acceptance/ Welcoming?

The Rite of Acceptance is for inquirers in

the RCIA process who are preparing for their Baptism. They are now ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey towards becoming Catholics. At this Rite, they are asked to more fully embrace the Gospel message with the help of God, and are also signed with the

Cross to show that they now belong to Christ, the Shepherd of souls. The Rite of Welcoming is

for inquirers who have been previously baptized and are ready to publicly declare their intention to continue their journey toward full communion with the Catholic Church. At this Rite, they are asked if they are ready to listen to the apostles' instruction, gather with the worshipping community in prayer, and join that community in the love and service of others. They are signed with the Cross to show that they belong to Christ.

The parish community has the opportunity and are encouraged to reach out to these inquirers as fellow members and to pray for them as they continue in their study in the coming months.
